LOCATION:

Tunnel Hill Christian Church 5105 Old Georgetown Road Georgetown, IN 47122

11 Miles North of Louisville, Kentucky just across the Ohio River in Indiana.

TIME: Show hall opens at 7:15 am; judging starts at 8:30 am. Show concludes by 5 p.m.

ENTRY INFORMATION:

- Full 8' Table Entry Fee With Lunch (\$65)
 Half Table With Lunch (\$50)
 Extra Lunch \$10
 Proxy horses \$3.00 per horses.
 Full 8' Table Entry Fee No Lunch (\$40)
 Half Table No Lunch (\$40)
- 2. NO REFUNDS of entry fees. If you cannot make the show, your entry fee becomes a donation.
- Entries will NOT be reserved without payment or a completed entry form (see attached).
 Walk-ins will not be accepted.
- 4. Your entry fee buys you ONE 8 foot table for show/display/sales. Extra tables must be purchased separately. Fees for extra tables are the same as entry fees.
- 5. If you have fewer than 25 horses, you MAY be asked to use a ROUND table. LONG 8" tables will be reserved for larger show strings if we exceed 32 entrants.
- 6. No fee/entry sharing is allowed. Everyone must personally own the models they are exhibiting, unless they are being proxy shown.
- 7. Proxy entries must clearly mark their entry form as a Proxy Entry and the entry will not be allocated table space (this shall be the responsibility of the proxy shower unless other arrangements are made).
- 8. Please complete the entry form and pay via PayPal (mameader@gmail.com via Friends and Family). Mail your signed entry to Melissa Meader. Checks or Money Orders must be made payable to Melissa Meader, 208 Brunswick Road, Louisville, Kentucky 40207.
- 9. Entrants are required to sign a release from liability form that needs to be submitted with your entry. If you pay entry fee via Paypal, you must still mail your signed entry form.

10. Please note: There will be a \$55 charge for any checks returned for insufficient funds (bank fee plus \$10). In addition to the insufficient funds charge, the check writer will be asked to pay cash/money order or via Paypal for any other shows, raffle tickets, or silent auction items in the future. Show host reserves the right to deny future show entries.

DIVISION INFORMATION:

OF China Open Production Division - <u>Any mass produced china defined as open runs or Limited edition runs of 1,000 or more.</u> This includes regular run Hagen Renakers (Produced in CA only), Breyer, Beswick, Royal Daulton, Napcoware, Lefton, Rosenthal, Hutschenreuther, Nymphenburg, Lakeshores, Royal Worcester's that are Open Edition pieces, etc.

OF China Limited Production Division - This would include Original Finish China with a Limited Production of 999 pieces or less and includes all test pieces. This includes LE Royal Worcester, All Artisan pieces such as Animal Artistry, Horsing Around, Bainbridge Fine China, Pour Horse, Share The Love, Hagen Renaker Tennessee, and Lakeshores under 1000 production are included, etc.

HALTER CLASS INFORMATION:

- 1. This is a Dual Judged show in Breed and Collectibility or Breed and Workmanship.
- 2. We are a NAN approved show. All NAMHSA rules will apply.
- **3.** Each halter horse may show in only one breed class.
- **4.** Specialty classes 1 3 are judged on collectability or workmanship and will receive yellow NAN cards. Please make sure to include your collectibility cards for classes 1 & 2.
- **5.** Models are to be identified with stringed tags. Side 1: breed and gender; Side 2: horse's name and owner's initials.
- 6. Collectability information is required for those horses in collectability classes. Horses without collectibility information will only be judged in Breed.
- 7. Classes will be placed first through fifth place paper ribbons. Custom Two layered Flats to Division Champ/Reserve. Custom Rosettes to Overall Champion and Reserve. Plus other items to be announced.

- **8.** No class limits for Halter classes. Unlimited number of entires in each class per shower. Judges may split classes further if needed.
- 9. There is a limit of three entries per class, per entrant for Specialty Classes and Artist Classes.
- 10. No animals (other than service dogs), young children unless they are showing, and no smoking are allowed. No foul language, or poor sportsmanship will be tolerated.
- **11.** No custom cold painted china will be allowed to show in any of the divisions.
- **12.** Any entrant who lays down a model understands that the judge will pick it up in order to be judged. Decisions of the judges and/or the show host are final.

COLLECTOR'S CLASS GUIDELINES:

- 1. Display entries must include ONLY SEVEN models.
- 2. Exhibitors are REQUIRED to display a card stating the display's collectable information for each piece.
- **3.** Displays will be judged on: Variety, Condition, Rarity, and Presentation.
- **4.** You may display OF and CMG together or just one or the other. They may be all one manufacturer and/or artist or a variety.
- **5.** Collector's Class be held at lunchtime.
- **6.** Prizes for top 4 placings TBD.
- 7. Limit One Collector's class entry per entrant.

LUNCH:

We will be taking a 30 minute Lunch Break. Lunch is available for pre-purchase when you register for \$10 per person. We will be serving lunch from Mark's Feed Store which is a local chain and favorite. Menu will include: Pulled Pork BBQ, Pulled Chicken BBQ, Red Potato Salad, Green Beans, Cole Slaw, Butter Milk Pie, and Iced Sweet Tea.

RAFFLE AND SILENT AUCTION: We will have raffle and silent auction items. We will accept donations of items to include in the raffle and auction and updating donors and items on our website.
